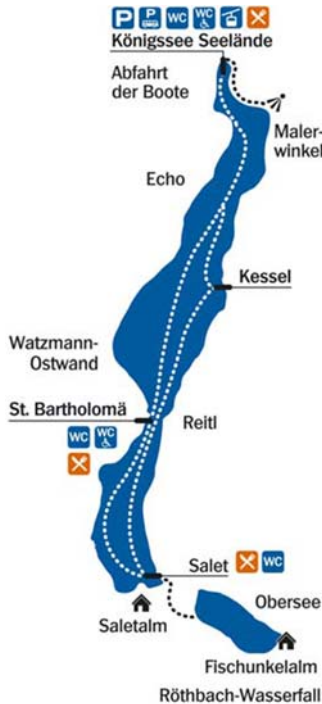


Interesting facts about Königssee Shipping

General information on shipping operations:



- ☀ Königssee Shipping sails **all year round** (except 24.12.).
- ☀ Our electric boats sail as required after the departure of the first scheduled boat (at least every 30 minutes, and more frequently when there are lots of visitors).
- ☀ **Travel time** to St. Bartholomä is approx. 35 mins. and to Salet approx. 55 mins.
- ☀ The stop at **Kessel** is only used **when requested**. Please ask the Captain.
- ☀ There is **no gastronomy** and **no toilet facilities** on board, but you will find:
 - A modern toilet facility with disabled toilets near the departure point at Königssee (view towards the lake, 1st boat hut on the left) and in Salet in the waiting room.
 - In St. Bartholomä, the toilets are in the waiting room at the pier. A disabled toilet is located in the side building of the restaurant towards the National Park Info point.

- ☀ **Wheelchairs and prams** can be transported albeit with restrictions.
- ☀ **Dogs** will only be transported when wearing **a muzzle, fighting dogs will generally not** be transported. Assistance dogs are exempt from the muzzle requirement.
- ☀ Disabled people or electric wheelchair users can rent a wheelchair free of charge (limited number, best to book beforehand).
- ☀ The circular trail in St. Bartholomä and the path from the pier at Salet to the Ober-Obersee is easy and well suited for wheelchairs.
- ☀ At the cashier's desks there are a limited number of **free lockers** for backpacks, biker helmets etc.
- ☀ **We also rent out rowing boats.**

An open word on the waiting times:

Despite the use of all boats, there may be some waiting times during the high season. Especially during the summer holidays, on beautiful weekends, on public holidays or on a bridge-day.

There may be capacity bottlenecks on the return trip from St. Bartholomä.

Experience has shown that the first beautiful day after a rainy period is also of great interest.

You can minimise waiting times on these days if you sail **before 10:00 a.m. to St. Bartholomä** and plan your return journey before the rush hour which starts at approx. 14:30.

Prices and special tickets for scheduled services:

- ☼ **Children up to 5 years** of age travel **free** when accompanied by an adult.
- ☼ **Children from 6 to 17 years** old receive a 50% discount (rounded up to the nearest 10 Cents).
- ☼ **Family discount on all scheduled trips** – When accompanied by full-paying adult (Mum, Dad, Grandma or Grandpa), the first own child or grandchild, from 6 to 17 years old, pays children`s rate. All further children/grandchildren from 6 to 17 years old pay only 1,00 € each.
- ☼ **Group rates** on trips to St. Bartholomä or Salet and back from 20 full paying people (10% discount; rounded up to the nearest 10 Cents).
- ☼ **Disabled people:** Group Price for round trip to St. Bartholomä or Salet on presentation of a valid original ID with a registered degree of disability of min. 70%.
- ☼ **BGL Day Ticket** (the Berchtesgadener Land Railway and RVO): 10% discount on trips to St. Bartholomä or Salet and back (only for adults).
- ☼ **Sea-Summit Ticket:** Boat Trip to St. Bartholomä incl. ascent and descent with the Jennerbahn Cable Car at a special price (available at the ticket offices of the Jennerbahn Cable Car or Königssee Shipping from May to October – due to the re-building of the Jennerbahn only available again from around Mid-2019).
