Fare for people with disabilities

Free travel with ID only and a valid disability token as per Art. 228 of the German Social Code (SGB IX). Present original ID with supplementary sheet to the boat cashier. Copies of ID cards will not be accepted. Fares will not be reimbursed retrospectively. You can obtain the token at your local social welfare office.

Even if you are entitled to free travel as per Art. 228 of the German Social Code (SGB IX), you still need a "free ticket You can obtain this from the boat conductor.

Accompanying persons

If a permanent escort is necessary and this is indicated by the symbol "B" in the ID presented, the accompanying person can also travel free of charge.

From guide dogs to wheelchairs

Anything that people with disabilities need to travel will be transported free of charge. This includes guide dogs, orthopedic aids, and wheelchairs.

Accessibility, jetties, and boarding the ships

The two large passenger ships MS TEGERNSEE and MS ROTTACH-EGERN are accessible and are used on the long tour.

The two large passenger ships can be boarded via a wheelchair-accessible bridge, which will be level or slightly inclined, depending on the water level. Due to the design of the bridges, there is a small threshold of approx. 5 cm (risk of tripping!). Our team will be happy to assist you.

The **jetties** at Tegernsee Rathaus (Jetty 1), Bräustüberl und Seesauna, in Rottach-Egern Überfahrt, Rottach-Egern Strandbad, Abwinkl, Bad Wiessee Ortsmitte, Gmund Seeglas, and Kaltenbrunn are **wheelchair-accessible**.

The Tegernsee Rathaus jetty (Jetty 2) is accessible via steps and is used to tether a smaller vessel. The **small units can be boarded without a connecting bridge**, with a small gap between the jetty and the ship. The

boarding height varies depending on the water level. Ships may sway during boarding if there are high waves.

On the ships

MS TEGERNSEE and MS ROTTACH-EGERN have an accessible restroom. The large salon on the main deck and the open spaces in the foredeck are wheelchair-accessible. The rear open deck and the upper deck can only be reached via a staircase. Catering available.

The **smaller ships** (MS GMUND, MS KREUTH, MS WALLBERG) do not have any restroom facilities and are **not wheelchair-accessible**. The salons and open decks can only be reached via stairs.

Accessible parking and public restrooms

These are located near the Tegernsee Rathaus, Rottach-Egern Strandbad, Bad Wiessee Ortsmitte, and Gmund Seeglas jetties.

Recommendations

We recommend **people with disabilities take a trip with the MS TEGERNSEE / ROTTACH-EGERN**. The ships run daily on the long tour (line A and usually line B). The jetties in Tegernsee (Rathaus Steg 1), Rottach-Egern Strandbad, and Bad Wiessee Ortsmitte are preferable as access points.
